

When can I apply to the Adlerbert scholarships?

You can only apply during the application period through the application system. The application period for the Adlerbert scholarship is between August 13th and September 15th 2020.

Why can't I see the Adlerbert scholarship in the application system?

The application form is only available during the application period.

If I am unable to apply in time, can I apply later?

No. No application sent in after the application deadline will be considered.

When can I expect to receive a decision regarding my application?

Whether you have been accepted or declined a scholarship will be sent by email in about a week's time after the Scholarship Committee convene in October. All applicants will be notified.

When will the grants be paid out?

The plan is to pay the Scholarship funds in November.

I will start studying a first or second cycle education in the autumn, can I apply for a scholarship?

No. To be eligible to apply for a scholarship you have to have studied at least two semesters at the University of Gothenburg.

Do I have to have earned any credits to be able to apply for a grant if I am studying at the first or second cycle?

Yes, you have to have earned at least 30 credits at the University of Gothenburg.

Are doctoral students eligible to apply for a grant?

Yes, if you are registered for doctoral studies at the University of Gothenburg when the application is submitted.

Can I apply for a scholarship if I have taken my doctoral degree?

No.

Are students from other universities eligible for the scholarship?

No, only registered students at the University of Gothenburg are eligible to apply.

What kind of travel can I apply for?

You can only apply for a travel that is relevant to your studies at the University of Gothenburg. Examples of acceptable travels are conferences, doctoral courses, summer school, study trips, field studies, studies abroad, internships abroad, thesis work or internships.

Can I apply for a travel without a given date?

No, the only trips that can be applied for at the 2020 application are trips that have taken place or are taking place between January 1st 2020 and June 30th 2022.

I have been on a trip during the spring semester, but will not study next Scholarship year can I still apply for a scholarship?

No, you have to study at the University of Gothenburg the same school year as the scholarship is granted, autumn/spring semester.

Can I apply for a scholarship for a trip within Sweden?

Yes. However, if the scholarship grants are not enough for every applicant, priority is given to trips outside Sweden.

What are housing scholarships?

The Adlerbert scholarships consist of four different foundations, of which two are housing foundations. These foundations grant housing scholarships. These housing costs can either be in connection with a travel or rent during the time studying in Gothenburg. Priority is given to housing costs connected to a travel.

Can doctoral student be granted a housing- or study scholarship?

No, these scholarships can only be awarded to students on their first or second cycle education.

How do I apply for a housing scholarship?

If you apply for a travel scholarship and specify Housing costs under the "Travel" tab you are also eligible for a housing scholarship. If you do not have any trip for which you can apply, you can instead apply for a housing scholarship by specifying Residential rent cost per month under the tab Category.

Can I apply for something else if I don't have a planned trip or any housing expenses?

Yes, if there are any grants left after all travel or housing scholarships have been granted, study scholarships can be given to applicants. All applications are considered to be application for study scholarship. Then you fill in everything except the Travel pages and Residential cost per month.

Do I need to attach anything to my application?

No, a control of results and registration via Ladok after the last application day. The election is based on the number of registered higher education credits and does not need any motivation.

I change address during the application period, which address should I enter?

Enter the address where we can reach you. For example by making an address change or being able to have the mail forwarded.

How much are the scholarship amounts?

Doctoral students receive 20,000 SEK.

First or second cycle students receive 15,000 SEK.

Do you get different amounts based on the scholarship you receive, i.e. travel, housing or study scholarships?

No, it does not matter which scholarship you receive.

Can I get more than one scholarship in one application period?

No, you can only be awarded one scholarship in one application round.

Is there any limit to how many scholarships I can get during my studies at the University of Gothenburg?

Yes. You can receive a maximum of two scholarships if you are a first or second cycle student. For doctoral students, only one scholarship can be granted. If you study at all levels you can therefore be granted the scholarship a maximum of three times. Scholarships received before 2016 are not included in this count.

How do I know how many scholarships I have received?

You can look it up in the application system. It shows all the Adlerbert scholarships you have received since 2016.

What happens if I pay a scholarship back in full?

The scholarship is removed and you can apply for that scholarship again at a later time.

Can I use a travel scholarship for another trip than the one I have specified?

Yes, as long the trip is relevant for your studies. You do not have to apply to change your trip, but you have to specify that another trip was undertaken when reporting it. The travel costs can either be specified directly in the application system provided you have BankID, or using the report form. The report form are available

Do I have to report housing or study scholarships?

No.

What happens if I end my studies at the university?

You have the right to keep the scholarship if you study at least half the pace during autumn 2020/spring 2021 semesters. If you do not, you have to pay the scholarship back.

If I have changed or incorrectly stated my bank account, can I change it in the application system by myself?

After the last application date has passed, you cannot change/correct the account information yourself in the application system. If you need to change your bank details you will have to contact the scholarship officers at stipendier@gu.se.

If I have changed my name, can I change it in the Application system by myself?

Yes.

If I have a new e-mail address, can I change it in the application system by myself?

No, you will have to contact the scholarship officers at stipendier@gu.se
