


# **STUDENT HEALTH CARE**



### **STUDENT ACCOUNT**

- 1. You use your student account to log in to the Student Portal and access the learning platform **Canvas** and the student record system **Ladok**.
- 2. Follow the instructions on how to activate your student account at the Student Portal. Use your Swedish personal number and the login for universityadmissions.se/antagning.se.
- 3. If you do not have a permanent Swedish personal identity number, you need support from <u>Servicecenter</u> to access your student account.



#### **LADOK** STUDENT RECORD SYSTEM

- Log in to Ladok through the Student Portal
- Register for courses
- See your registrations
- See your finished courses and grades
- View and print a verifiable **study certificate**
- See and change your contact information
- Sign up for examination
- Apply for a degree



#### **CANVAS** ONLINE LEARNING PLATFORM

- Log in to Canvas through the Student Portal
- Information on courses such as schedules, literature, contact info, exam dates.
- Communication and collaboration between teachers and students.
- Registered in Ladok on a course to get access.
- Download the Canvas student app (Google/Apple Store).

### **ELECTIVE COURSES**

### **SIGN UP FOR COURSES**

- You are responsible for signing up (register) before each course in Ladok!
- Academic calendar (autumn & spring)
- Semester divided in four study periods
- Deadline for registration!

### **TEACHING & EXAMINATIONS**

- Different courses will have different teaching methods
- Different types of examinations
- Assignments, group work and written exams
- Check the course syllabus and/or Canvas



### **EXAMS**

- You must register in advance for written exams in the examination hall!
- Cancel if you are unable to attend.
- If you do not register, you will **not** be able to write the exam.
- The web registration opens 3 weeks before the exam and **closes 10 days** before the exam.
- Register for exams in Ladok.
- All exams are marked anonymously.
- Exam results are published on the web page for the course (Canvas).
- Number of exams offered: 1 exam, 1 re-exam and sometimes 1 exam in end of August.



### **STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES**

- There are *four* student representatives per programme (two representatives per programme and year).
- Important link between students and course responsible teachers, programme coordinators in regard to course evaluations, views on the education, and other student related issues.
- You find the representatives at the Student Portal pages.
- More information and selection in early September.








