Proof of English language proficiency: Courses are taught in English or Portuguese. Insper recommends exchange students to have a CEFR B2 level of English, but don't require any English proficiency test.

For master studies, a B2 level in Portuguese is required. A letter from the Home University attesting the student is able to take courses in Portuguese is enough.
