



# Exchange Studies - Global Public Health

## 2026/27

To: MGH/MPH students interested in Exchanges 2026/27

It is possible to apply for and do exchange studies during the third semester in our international programs in public or global health. Interested students can apply for courses (or internship) abroad, free of choice, on a bachelor's or master's level at our selected partner universities. The courses should be in the field of or related to global/public health. Credits obtained after successfully completing studies abroad are transferred upon request and included in the student's degree. [Credit transfer | Student Portal](#)

### Agreements

The agreements, faculty agreements and university-wide agreements are all listed in the same application form. There are two different maps (search fields) to figure out where to study. It depends if you are interested in applying for a seat on faculty agreements or university-wide agreements, or possibly both.

**SA Faculty Agreements – please note all faculty agreements will be removed 2026/2027 since they expire and we have excluded internship possibilities through exchange agreements**

### University-Wide Agreements

University-wide agreements are open to all students at the University of Gothenburg. This means that you compete with students from all other faculties at UGOT if you choose to apply for a seat on these agreements. University-wide agreements are not quality assured by our teachers. It is up to you (the student) to double-check if the partner university offers courses in public health/global health before applying. Please note it is only possible to apply for full-time studies (equivalent to 30 HP) on the university-wide agreements. *Theoretical courses only, no internships or data collection possibilities through university-wide agreements.*

## Requirements

### General requirements:

- Be registered and study full-time at Sahlgrenska Academy at the time of application and semester before the actual exchange.
- Have completed a minimum of 30 higher education credits before exchange.
- Have passed all examinations within the study program.
- Meet the language requirements for the exchange (according to partner university).
- Meet other requirements that might be specific to the partner university.

### Selection Criteria

General selection criteria for all study programs at Sahlgrenska Academy:

- It is a merit to *have been* a buddy for an incoming international student through INTET (student Union).

### Specific selection criteria for MGH/MPH:

Passed (G) in all courses at first attempt (MPH211, 212, 213, maximum points = 30 credits). Thereafter, total amount of VG's. [Selection criteria Public Global Health 2026 2027.pdf](#)

## Application Process

The application consists of the following mandatory parts:

- Online application in Mobility Online (system for international activities at GU).



- CV in English (or in the language you intend to study).  
Motivation letter (600 words) written in the language of instruction at your first choice of exchange destination.
- Ladok transcript with completed courses and full grades.
- Other documents that may show participation in activities that are seen as merits in the application process (e.g., student buddy in INTE).

**Deadline: 1 February 2026, 23:59. The application link will open approximately 6 weeks prior to the deadline.**

### **Insurance During Your Exchange**

All students participating in an exchange are covered by the Swedish State's Insurance during education abroad (Student UT) via Kammarkollegiet. The insurance applies 24/7 in the host country, starting 14 days before and ending 14 days after the exchange period. Read the terms and conditions carefully and consider complementary insurance if needed.

#### Erasmus+ Bilateral Agreements
