Through studies in epidemiology, social epidemiology, quantitative and qualitative research methods, and health economics, you will develop a deep, practical understanding of how health systems function. With both introductory and advanced courses in health economics, you will be well prepared to shape healthier, more equitable societies.

Qualification for admission to the programme requires professional degree/Bachelor's degree of at least 180 credits in a health science, social science, science, economics, arts or engineering field of education and English: English 6. Or: English level 2.
